Why this order

A forty-page workbook is a commitment, and a child who stalls on page three has quietly learned that this is a thing they fail at. Five pages is small enough that finishing feels normal. That first finished week is worth more than any amount of good intention.

How to use it

One page a day for five days. About ten minutes each.

If it goes well, the full eight-week Summer Refresher picks up exactly where this stops — and it is free too, like everything else here.

If it does not go well, you have lost five sheets of paper. Try a different level, or try the five-minute activities instead. Neither of those costs anything either.
